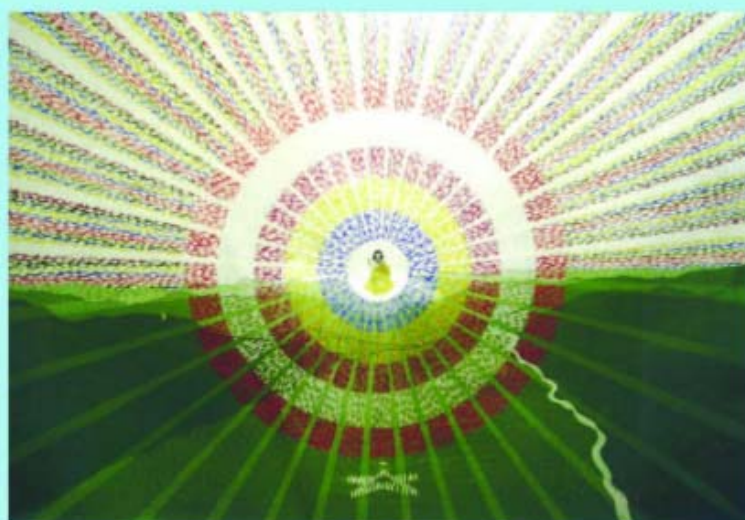

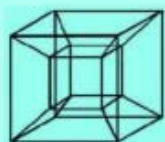

DESCRIPTION OF CONTENTS

Professor Hocking describes a little-known method (expert-level Remote Viewing) which has given useful information in chemistry & physics and has also been used by the CIA and others to obtain covert intelligence information. Simple methods are given to attain such an ability. (continued below...)

Expert-level Remote Viewing has revealed new information on historical figures, e.g. revealing lost details of the life of Christ. In the absence of other new sources, this is of great interest.

Expert-level Remote viewing is a controlled vivid-daydreaming state, which it is shown, cannot be dismissed as hallucinations. Depriving the normal 5 senses of all input allows the very faint subliminal 6th sense to be perceived. Moving seamlessly from the waking state into a lucid dreamstate, without losing consciousness, traditionally requires years of meditation or is a born ability (e.g. William Blake, St Teresa, etc), but two easy methods are described here: a flotation tank, and lucid dreaming methods: an entry into visionary experiences & insights, and opening possibilities of scientific and engineering invention. Edison used the dreamstate to obtain many of his inventions.

Very ancient flying machines were observed, operating in Atlantis 13,000 years ago, which may have partial links to modern “stealth” aircraft (high voltage lift). Vast tsunamis from the sinking of Atlantis 12,000 years ago swept away archaeological evidence and re-started a Stone Age.

This book answers the following objections cited by atheists to religion:

Atheists say that there is no evidence for God, nor for heaven and hell; and that disasters kill apparently innocent people including children, so God is unjust if God exists. But all these are shown by strong evidence presented, to be incorrect. The book counteracts the rise of atheism, for general readers who want to study the new evidence given. Evidence is given that we have all lived many past lives. Atheism has studiously ignored important facts.

I saw the original BBC TV series about 1960 and he repeatedly was able to accurately read lines from books in distant libraries just from a random selection of:

shelf location, book position on the shelf from the left, page number, line number. Canasta then spoke that line. After that, someone in the distant library would go to that shelf and select the book from the position given, find the page and line, and the person in the distant library would read out the line. It was exactly correct.

This was correctly done several times, with different books selected.

There was no explanation and the BBC said there was no collusion with Canasta.

Yuschak has published scientific papers on galantamine -- see also T. Yuschak, "Advanced Lucid Dreaming", ISBN 978-1-4303-0542-2 -- **This one is essential reading** – covers use of herbal supplements (which, unlike narcotic drugs, do not alter one's waking behaviour) to produce immediate lucid dreams and OBEs, including seamless transition from waking to lucid dreamstate consciousness ('WILD'). Apart from nicotine, the ones mentioned are described as non-addictive, unlike many narcotic drugs.

Other lucid dreaming methods (non-herbal):

An interesting website is www.lucidology.net (first see the associated website www.saltcube.com) where Nick Newport gives details of how the sleep paralysis phenomenon can be used to enter lucid dreams. His idea is that the body induces sleep paralysis at the time of falling asleep to protect itself from sleepwalking, but that entering this state can be done in a controlled way which tricks the body to think you have already fallen asleep, in which state it then seems easy to allow a WILD or OBE to occur. This may be easier for some people than for others. He also advocates the use of alarm timer programmes which he supplies. He has a series of 12 short videos on YouTube. He also sells detailed instructions in worthwhile videos purchased from his website, www.lucidology.net which are informative and useful. The writer (MGH) does not know if the YouTube videos are copyright or not and makes no suggestion to copy them.

General note: In case these videos are ever withdrawn, it is possible to download YouTube videos using YouTube Downloader (from <http://youtubedownloader.altervista.org>). A video format converter (Prism Video File Converter Plus, from NCH Software) is needed after downloading, to convert it to a .mov video file.

The writer (MGH) has not tested this.

Additional Information: The writer's first book [1] gave methods for achieving altered states of consciousness. Another method was developed centuries ago by Sufis, in the "whirling dervishes" branch. In this, a Sufi whirls around at about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a turn per second. A ballet dancer, turns her head in fast steps unrelated to her (continuous) pirouette, so that her head is stationary while her body turns and then suddenly turns to "catch up" with it, to avoid dizziness, but in contrast with this the Sufis keep their head turning continuously with their body. For the first month or two they get dizzy, but then suddenly the dizziness ceases. The writer's (MGH's) opinion is that the centrifugal effect of Sufi whirling reduces the blood pressure in the frontal lobes, which allows entry to an altered state of consciousness; Cf the effect of pranayama [1, 2]. Sufis report entering an altered state of union with a higher aspect of themselves. Caution: Beginners need to take extreme care, as dizziness can cause heavy falls in unexpected directions, perhaps striking one's head on furniture. Adequate precautions must be taken against this. A method which has been used experimentally [3] was to wear a harness fixed by a rope to a secure overhead support, which can rotate (e.g. the centre ring of a roller bearing). To avoid the support rope touching the head, two ropes (one from each shoulder) were used, fastened to the ends of a strong horizontal wood strip, which was suspended by a single rope from the centre ring of the roller bearing. The bearing was fastened by a band around an exposed overhead joist, not by a screwed-in eyelet which might be pulled out! Rotation should be clockwise (as seen from above), i.e. turn only to the right. A cyclist safety helmet was worn in case anything broke. Another person was available in case of an unforeseen mishap. Only a short time was spent whirling at first, starting at low speed and gradually increasing day-by-day as dizziness was overcome. Sufi dervishes [4] report that dizziness suddenly stops, achieved after several months.
